

Jeannie Cho Lee wine dinner at Park Hyatt Seoul

Sept. 8: The Park Hyatt Seoul is presenting a special wine dinner with Jeannie Cho Lee, the first Asian person to become accredited as a Master of Wine by The Institute of Masters of Wine in the United Kingdom. Lee is also a wine educator, journalist and wine consultant.

The event will include a presentation by Lee on her newly published book, "Mastering Wine" and a five-course dinner with matching wines selected by Lee.

The dinner menu includes sea bass tartare with organic young leaves, Korean black chicken tortelli with mushroom ragout, Korean beef tenderloin with sweet pumpkin gnocchi and squash, Hong Ssang Ri plum tea with iced persimmon and more.

During the event, Lee will offer information on wine making, wine tasting and understanding wine labels. She aims to offer a fresh perspective on understanding and appreciating wines by matching them with Korean ingredients such as red dates, persimmons, gingko nuts and more.

The event is priced at 169,000 won per person excluding tax.

Lee's book, valued at 80,000 won, will be given to dinner guests as a gift.

Seating is limited to 60 guests and reservations must be made in advance.
