

Jeannie Cho Lee '90 releases "Mastering Wine for the Asian Palate"

This summer Master of Wine **Jeannie Cho Lee '90** promoted the launch of her new book, *Mastering Wine for the Asian Palate*.

Jeannie, who was born in Seoul and is now based in Hong Kong, became a Master of Wine in 2008. In doing so, she joined fewer than 300 others with the title and became the first ethnic Asian to earn the distinction. A Master of Wine is internationally recognized "as the pinnacle of professional achievement in the world of wine."

Jeannie's official website, <u>Asian Palate</u>, is billed as "the juncture where Asian food and wine meet." Her website and new book are the follow up to Jeannie's first book, *Asian Palate*, which was published in 2009. *Asian Palate* was well-received, earning the "Best Food and Wine Pairing Book in the World" award at the 2010 Gourmand World Cookbook Awards and won a number of other awards in 2010 and 2011.
